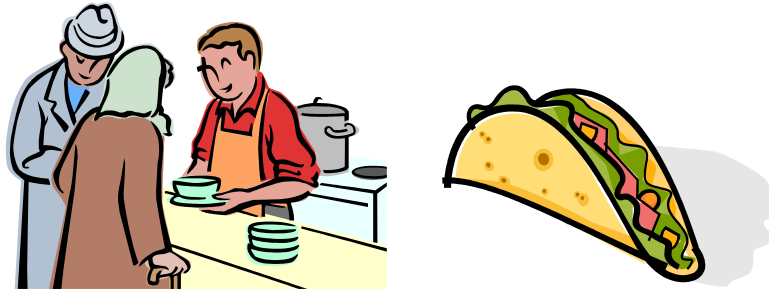


## PLS Public Service Projects

### Loaves and Fishes

On Wednesday, June 4, 2014, Public Law Section volunteers together with volunteers from U.S. Bank once again set up and cooked a meal for approximately 225 people through the Loaves and Fishes program. We broke from tradition. Rather than the typical Tator Tot Hot Dish, we instead prepared beef tacos. Though there was some grumbling in the ranks of the cooking volunteers, the meal was well received by our guests. We are going to try it one more time in August before returning to the Tator Tots in October. The meal is served in the basement of the Holy Rosary church at 2424 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue South in Minneapolis. The public lawyers and bankers cook the meal and do set up and the University of Wisconsin – Madison alumni serve the meal and clean up. Future meals will be cooked up on **August 6, October 1** and **December 3**. Cooking/set up starts at around 3:00 and is finished at 5:00. The Badger alums would also welcome you if you would like to help with serving and clean up instead (5:00 – 7:00).
