




Establishing an LID Methods

- County board action
- Petition of majority of property owners
- Action by Minnesota DNR
- Referendum by 26% of property owners

Establishing an LID Procedure

- Petition or Board Action Request (BAR)
- Public and local government notification
- Public Hearing
- Advisory Report by Minnesota DNR
- Findings and Order by County

Establishing an LID Petition or Board Action

- Boundary of LID (Watershed)
- Justification for LID
- Action proposed
- Financing
- Governance

Issues Liability

- Private Insurance
- Minnesota Counties Insurance Trust

Initial Meeting

- Held in July or August
- Board appointed by County with majority residents of LID
- Election of Officers Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer
- Bank Account
- Meeting minutes

Future Meetings

- Board election determined by county resolution
 - Mail
 - Election at the meeting

- RFP and selection of treatment applicator
